



## **Babylon King's Gold Statue Story**

Daniel 3:1-30

Sketch #1: Idol & worshippers - This picture is the story logo. Let me tell you a story about a king who tried to make the whole world worship a gigantic statue of himself.

Sketch #2: Idol, pagan, & Jew - This sketch illustrates the first part of the story where the Babylonian leaders worship the statue, but Shadrach and his friends will not worship it.

Sketch #3: Flames - This sketch illustrates the second part of the story where King Nebuchadnezzar threatens the young men with death and throws them into the furnace.

Sketch #4: Open door - This sketch illustrates the third part of the story where the king sees an angel walking in the fire with the men. He releases them and begins to believe in the true God. The door to the king's heart is now open.

### **Storyteller Discipleship**

The following activities will help you remember the story, apply wisdom to your own life, and tell the story to others.

- Listen to the story.
- Draw the story.
- Tell the story with the drawings.
- Draw your own pictures to illustrate the story.
- Pray and ask the Holy Spirit to reveal wisdom in the story.

- Draw a map of your family and friends and pray for them.
- Go and tell the story to someone. Discuss the story.
- Disciple others to become Spirit-filled storytellers.
