

Pagan Beast King Story Daniel 4:1-37

<u>Sketch #1</u>: Tree & star - This sketch is the story logo. Let me tell you about a king who dreamed about a tree and became like a beast until he worshiped God.

<u>Sketch #2</u>: Cloud & tree - This sketch illustrates the first part of the story where King Nebuchadnezzar had a dream about the future, and Daniel interprets the dream.

<u>Sketch #3</u>: Beast - This sketch illustrates the second part of the story where the dream comes true. God humbles the king by making him like an animal for seven seasons.

<u>Sketch #4</u>: Praising king - This sketch illustrates the third part of the story where the king worships Yahweh as the only God. God returns his sanity and dominion back to him.

- Listen to the story.
- Draw the story.
- Tell the story with the drawings.
- · Draw your own pictures to illustrate the story.
- Pray and ask the Holy Spirit to reveal wisdom in the story.

- Draw a map of your family and friends and pray for them.
- Go and tell the story to someone. Discuss the story.
- Disciple others to become Spirit-filled storytellers.
