



Joseph Interprets Dreams Story

Genesis 40:1-23

Sketch #1: Cloud & chains - This sketch is the story logo. Let me tell you a story about a dream interpreter in prison.

Sketch #2: Prison bars - This sketch illustrates the first part of the story where Joseph meets Pharaoh's servants in jail and takes care of them.

Sketch #3: Cup & bread - This sketch illustrates the second part of the story where Joseph listens to and interprets the two dreams about the future.

Sketch #4: Man & bone - This sketch illustrates the third part of the story where the dreams come true: the cupbearer lives and the baker dies. Joseph is forgotten.

Storyteller Discipleship

The following activities will help you remember the story, apply wisdom to your own life, and tell the story to others.

- Listen to the story.
- Draw the story.
- Tell the story with the drawings.
- Draw your own pictures to illustrate the story.
- Pray and ask the Holy Spirit to reveal wisdom in the story.
- What is the Holy Spirit asking you to do next?
- Draw a map of your family and friends and pray for them.
- Go and tell the story to someone. Discuss the story.
- Disciple others to become Spirit-filled storytellers.
