



Noah's Rainbow Covenant Story

Genesis 8:1 - 9:17

Sketch #1: Cloud, rainbow, & boat - This sketch is the story logo. Let me tell you a story about the first rainbow.

Sketch #2: Dove & olive branch - This sketch illustrates the first part of the story where the flood is over, and Noah sends the birds out searching for dry land.

Sketch #3: Altar, lamb, & fire - This sketch illustrates the second part of the story where God commands Noah and his family to depart the ark, and Noah sacrifices a burnt offering to honor the Lord.

Sketch #4: Cloud & rainbow - This sketch illustrates the third part of the story where God establishes a new covenant with Noah. He will never destroy humanity again by flood and explains the meaning of the rainbow sign.

Storyteller Discipleship

The following activities will help you remember the story, apply wisdom to your own life, and tell the story to others.

- Listen to the story.
- Draw the story.
- Tell the story with the drawings.
- Draw your own pictures to illustrate the story.
- Pray and ask the Holy Spirit to reveal wisdom in the story.
- What is the Holy Spirit asking you to do next?
- Draw a map of your family and friends and pray for them.
- Go and tell the story to someone. Discuss the story.
- Disciple others to become Spirit-filled storytellers.
