Hebrews 4:1-13

Sketch #1: Open door & river - This sketch is the story logo. Let me tell you a story about a special sanctuary God made for us to rest and refresh in his presence.

Sketch #2: Cloud & dawn - This sketch illustrates God modeling sabbath rest for his people. He created everything in six days, and then set apart the seventh day for rest.

Sketch #3: Crown, barrier, & heart - This sketch illustrates a person rejecting God's command to rest. We do not only listen to him, we also love, obey, and enjoy his Spirit.

Sketch #4: Sword & heart - This sketch illustrates Jesus Christ as God's Word. His truth and resurrection life penetrates our hearts, reveals sin, and sets us free!

Storyteller Discipleship

The following activities will help you remember the story, apply wisdom to your own life, and tell the story to others.

- Listen to the story.
- Draw the story.
- Tell the story with the drawings.
- Draw your own pictures to illustrate the story.
- Pray and ask the Holy Spirit to reveal wisdom in the story.

- Draw a map of your family and friends and pray for them.
- Go and tell the story to someone. Discuss the story.
- Disciple others to become Spirit-filled storytellers.
