

Remain In Me Story John 15:1-17

<u>Sketch #1</u>: Vineyard keeper & vine - This sketch is the story logo. Let me tell you a story about how God wants us to rest in his presence every day so we can be free.

<u>Sketch #2</u>: Vine, branches, & fruit - This sketch illustrates Jesus as our Master and Source of Life. The fruitful branch is a disciple who remains in Jesus and obeys him.

<u>Sketch #3</u>: Burning branches - This sketch illustrates the Father cutting off branches unreceptive to living water. They burn up and are blown away, because they are dead.

<u>Sketch #4</u>: Crucified Christ - This sketch illustrates the love of Jesus for us: he gave his life as a sign of perfect love, and he invites his disciples to lay down their lives as well.

Storyteller Discipleship

- Listen to the story.
- · Draw the story.
- Tell the story with the drawings.
- Draw your own pictures to illustrate the story.
- Pray and ask the Holy Spirit to reveal wisdom in the story.

- Go and tell the story to someone. Discuss the story.
