



## **Fish And Bread Feast Story**

John 6:1-15

Sketch #1: Fish & loaf - This sketch is the story logo. Let me tell you a story about how Jesus fed 5,000 men and their families with two fish and five loaves of bread.

Sketch #2: Jesus & boy - This sketch illustrates the first part of the story where Jesus instructs the disciples to feed the crowd, and a little boy offers his lunch to them.

Sketch #3: Feast - This sketch illustrates the second part of the story where Jesus prayed over the meal, and his disciples fed all 5,000 men and their families.

Sketch #4: Cloud & crown - This sketch illustrates the third part of the story where the crowd tries to make Jesus their king, and he escapes to the mountain to be alone.

### **Storyteller Discipleship**

The following activities will help you remember the story, apply wisdom to your own life, and tell the story to others.

- Listen to the story.
- Draw the story.
- Tell the story with the drawings.
- Draw your own pictures to illustrate the story.
- Pray and ask the Holy Spirit to reveal wisdom in the story.
- What is the Holy Spirit asking you to do next?
- Draw a map of your family and friends and pray for them.
- Go and tell the story to someone. Discuss the story.
- Disciple others to become Spirit-filled storytellers.
