



Walking On Water Story

John 6:16-21

Sketch #1: Jesus on water - This sketch is the story logo. Let me tell you a story about how Jesus rescued his disciples from drowning by walking on water.

Sketch #2: Boat - This sketch illustrates the first part of the story where Jesus' disciples waited for their Master and then decided to sail home at night when He did not return.

Sketch #3: Wind - This sketch illustrates the second part of the story where the disciples became lost in a raging storm. They saw Jesus walking on water and were afraid.

Sketch #4: Believing disciple - This sketch illustrates the third part of the story where Jesus' disciples witness Him transport their boat instantly across a great distance.

Storyteller Discipleship

The following activities will help you remember the story, apply wisdom to your own life, and tell the story to others.

- Listen to the story.
- Draw the story.
- Tell the story with the drawings.
- Draw your own pictures to illustrate the story.
- Pray and ask the Holy Spirit to reveal wisdom in the story.

- Draw a map of your family and friends and pray for them.
- Go and tell the story to someone. Discuss the story.
- Disciple others to become Spirit-filled storytellers.
