



Blind Beggar Healing Story

John 9:1-41

Sketch #1: Blind man - This sketch is the story logo. Let me tell you a story about Jesus healing a poor, blind beggar.

Sketch #2: Water - This sketch illustrates the first part of the story where Jesus rubs spit and mud on the beggar's eyes. He washes in a pool called "Sent," and he sees. Hallelujah!

Sketch #3: Witness - This sketch illustrates the second part of the story where the man is healed and boldly declares his miracle testimony to the local governing leaders.

Sketch #4: Judge gavel - This sketch illustrates the third part of the story where the local leaders judged the man evil, but Jesus judged him as faithful and blessed him.

Storyteller Discipleship

The following activities will help you remember the story, apply wisdom to your own life, and tell the story to others.

- Listen to the story.
- Draw the story.
- Tell the story with the drawings.
- Draw your own pictures to illustrate the story.
- Pray and ask the Holy Spirit to reveal wisdom in the story.
- What is the Holy Spirit asking you to do next?
- Draw a map of your family and friends and pray for them.
- Go and tell the story to someone. Discuss the story.
- Disciple others to become Spirit-filled storytellers.
