



Lost Son Story

Luke 15:11-32

Sketch #1: Son & pig - This sketch is the story logo. Let me tell you a story about a wealthy family who lost their son.

Sketch #2: Stick & travel bag - This sketch illustrates the first part of the story where the lost son asks for his inheritance early and travels to a foreign land alone.

Sketch #3: Pig - This sketch illustrates the second part of the story where the lost son becomes the starving servant of a pig farmer.

Sketch #4: Table & meal - This sketch illustrates the third part of the story where the father forgives his lost son and explains his decision to the angry, jealous brother.

Storyteller Discipleship

The following activities will help you remember the story, apply wisdom to your own life, and tell the story to others.

- Listen to the story.
- Draw the story.
- Tell the story with the drawings.
- Draw your own pictures to illustrate the story.
- Pray and ask the Holy Spirit to reveal wisdom in the story.
- What is the Holy Spirit asking you to do next?
- Draw a map of your family and friends and pray for them.
- Go and tell the story to someone. Discuss the story.
- Disciple others to become Spirit-filled storytellers.
