



Jesus Christ Crucified Story

Luke 23:26-43

Sketch #1: Three crosses - This sketch is the story logo. Let me tell you a story about the Savior of the world being nailed to a cross between two convicted thieves.

Sketch #2: Hammer & nail - This sketch illustrates the first part of the story where Roman soldiers nailed Jesus of Nazareth to a cross.

Sketch #3: Crown - This sketch illustrates the second part of the story where several people witnessing Jesus' death mocked him for claiming to be Messiah and King.

Sketch #4: Cloud & man - This sketch illustrates the third part of the story where Jesus prophesies that the repentant criminal will be with him in heaven that same day.

Storyteller Discipleship

The following activities will help you remember the story, apply wisdom to your own life, and tell the story to others.

- Listen to the story.
- Draw the story.
- Tell the story with the drawings.
- Draw your own pictures to illustrate the story.
- Pray and ask the Holy Spirit to reveal wisdom in the story.
- What is the Holy Spirit asking you to do next?
- Draw a map of your family and friends and pray for them.
- Go and tell the story to someone. Discuss the story.
- Disciple others to become Spirit-filled storytellers.
