



## Calming The Storm Story

Mark 4:35-41

Sketch #1: Jesus, boat, sea, & storm – This sketch is the story logo. Let me tell you a story about a storm that listened to Jesus.

Sketch #2: Jesus, disciples, & boat – This sketch illustrates the first part of the story where Jesus and his disciples leave the crowds, climb into a boat, and cross over to the other side of the sea.

Sketch #3: Cloud & lightning bolt – This sketch illustrates the second part of the story where the disciples wake up Jesus. He calms the storm and sea.

Sketch #4: Sun & water – This sketch illustrates the third part of the story where the calm sea and clear day resulted from Jesus' authority and power over nature.

### Storyteller Discipleship

The following activities will help you remember the story, apply wisdom to your own life, and tell the story to others.

- Listen to the story.
- Draw the story.
- Tell the story with the drawings.
- Draw your own pictures to illustrate the story.
- Pray and ask the Holy Spirit to reveal wisdom in the story.
- What is the Holy Spirit asking you to do next?
- Draw a map of your family and friends and pray for them.
- Go and tell the story to someone. Discuss the story.
- Disciple others to become Spirit-filled storytellers.
