

Four Soils Story Mark 4:1-20

<u>Sketch #1</u>: Farmer sowing seeds - This picture is the story logo. Let me tell you a story about a farmer who sowed seeds on four different soils.

<u>Sketch #2</u>: Seed & soil: This sketch illustrates the first part of the story where Jesus teaches and begins this story with a farmer who sows seed on hard soil.

<u>Sketch #3</u>: Rocks & thorns: This sketch illustrates the second part of the story where Jesus describes the second and third types of receptive but unfruitful soils.

<u>Sketch #4</u>: Plant & roots - This sketch illustrates the third part of the story where Jesus describes the healthy fourth soil that bears a fruitful, multiplying crop.

Storyteller Discipleship

- Listen to the story.
- · Draw the story.
- Tell the story with the drawings.
- Draw your own pictures to illustrate the story.
