



## **Jesus Christ Dies Story**

Matthew 27:45-56

Sketch #1: Jesus crying out - This sketch is the story logo. Let me tell you a story about the day Jesus Messiah died.

Sketch #2: Cross - This sketch illustrates the first part of the story where Jesus dies on the cross.

Sketch #3: Torn veil - This sketch illustrates the second part of the story where many signs accompanied Jesus' death such as an earthquake, the dead raised, and the torn temple veil.

Sketch #4: Roman soldier - This sketch illustrates the third part of the story where Jesus' family and friends wept at his death, and the pagan Roman soldier believed in Jesus as God's Son.

## **Storyteller Discipleship**

The following activities will help you remember the story, apply wisdom to your own life, and tell the story to others.

- Listen to the story.
- Draw the story.
- Tell the story with the drawings.
- Draw your own pictures to illustrate the story.
- Pray and ask the Holy Spirit to reveal wisdom in the story.
- What is the Holy Spirit asking you to do next?
- Draw a map of your family and friends and pray for them.
- Go and tell the story to someone. Discuss the story.
- Disciple others to become Spirit-filled storytellers.
