



David's Broken Heart Story

2 Samuel 12:1-25

Beloved Lamb - altar, lamb, knife - Let me tell you a story about the day King David's infant son died.

Diabolical Division - woman, king, fallen man - God was enraged by David's murder of Uriah. He sent the prophet Nathan to tell David a story about the death of an innocent lamb, and how his death plot against Uriah was pure evil.

Violence Curse - crown, house, sword - God judged David. His punishment was future brutality in all generations of his family tree. What David did secretly would happen publicly.

Death & Life - tombstone, king, baby - David's son became very ill. He begged God for mercy, but the child died. After grieving, David and Bathsheba had a son named Solomon.
