Moses Hears & Fears (Exodus 4:1-20)

Jesus' Holy Spirit invites us to hear God's voice. Listening and hearing are not the same. We can be in two situations. One, you hear something and you begin listening intently. Two, you are listening to something, and you begin to really hear what they're saying. We witness so clearly the humanity of prophets when Moses stands barefoot before the burning bush. God commissions Moses as his ambassador to deliver Israel from slavery. As Moses listens to God speaking, he clearly hears what God wants him to do and becomes afraid and asks God to send someone else. Let us hear Jesus' voice and follow wherever he leads.
