Available Rescuer

The righteous call to the LORD, and he listens; he rescues them from all their troubles. The LORD is near to those who are discouraged; he saves those who have lost all hope. (Psalm 34:17-18 GNT)

Setting Captives Free (Acts 16:16-34)

Jesus' Holy Spirit invites us to cry out for deliverance. The greatest test of humility is to admit we need help. We live in a self-help culture, but the Gospel says, "You can't help yourself." In this story, we see at least three acts of deliverance: the demon-possessed girl, Paul and Silas in prison, and the jailer's family. In each case, the one needing deliverance was helpless. They needed rescue from their bondage: oppression by evil spirits, locked up in chains, and hell bound. God broke through the darkness and strongholds with authority, power, and glory. Afterward, everyone experienced new freedom in Christ. Use these Scriptures to tear down strongholds in your heart. Pray for deliverance in oppression, temptation, persecution, and battles.

Discipleship & Prayer

- What can I do after I identify idols in my life?

- Holy Spirit, use my life as a vessel for your freedom.

Ancient Doors > Lift up your heads, O gates! And be lifted up, O ancient doors, that the King of Glory may come in. Who is this King of Glory? The LORD, strong and mighty, the LORD, mighty in battle!
(Psalm 24:7-8 ESV)

Battlefield Rescue > My LORD sent from above, He took me and drew me out of many waters. He delivered me from my strong enemy, from those who hated me; for they were too strong for me. They confronted me in the day of my calamity, but the LORD was my support. He also brought me out into a broad place; He delivered me because He delighted in me.
(2 Samuel 22:17-20 NKJV)

Braveheart > David the shepherd boy said, “The LORD, who delivered me from the paw of the lion and from the paw of the bear, He will deliver me from the hand of this Philistine.” And King Saul said to David, “Go, and the LORD be with you!” (1 Samuel 17:37 NKJV)

Death Obeys > Jesus tenderly clasped the child’s hand in his and said to her, “Little girl, wake up from the sleep of death.” Instantly, she sat up, stood to her feet, and started walking around the room! Everyone was overcome with astonishment in seeing this miracle! (Mark 5:41-42 TPT)

Deliverance Songs > Let all the faithful pray to you while you may be found; surely the rising of the mighty waters will not reach them. You are my Hiding Place; you will protect me from trouble and surround me with songs of deliverance. (Psalm 32:6-7 NIV)

Fearless > Then you will go on your way in safety, and your foot will not stumble. When you lie down, you will not be afraid; when you lie down, your sleep will be sweet. Have no fear of sudden disaster or of the ruin that overtakes the wicked, for the LORD will be at your side and will keep your foot from being snared.
(Proverbs 3:23-26 NIV)

Kingdom Transfer > God has rescued us from the domain of darkness and transferred us into the kingdom of the Son He loves. We have redemption, the forgiveness of sins, in Him.
(Colossians 1:13-14 HCSB)

Listening LORD > The righteous cry out, and the LORD hears and delivers them out of all their troubles. The LORD is near to those who have a broken heart and saves such as have a contrite spirit. Many are the afflictions of the righteous, but the LORD delivers him out of them all. He guards all his bones; not one of them is broken. (Psalm 34:17-20 NKJV)

Martyr's Triumph > I heard a loud voice in heaven say, "Now have come the salvation and the power and the kingdom of our God, and the authority of his Messiah. For the accuser of our brothers and sisters, who accuses them before our God day and night, has been hurled down. They triumphed over him by the blood of the Lamb and by the word of their testimony. They did not love their lives so much as to shrink from death."
(Revelation 12:10-11 NIV)

Preserve Me > Though I walk in the midst of trouble, you preserve my life. You stretch out your hand against the anger of my foes; with your right hand you save

me. The LORD will vindicate me; your love, LORD, endures forever. Do not abandon the works of your hands. (Psalm 138:7-8 NIV)

Shepherd's Comfort > Even though I walk through the darkest valley, I will fear no evil, for you are with me; your rod and your staff, they comfort me. You prepare a table before me in the presence of my enemies. You anoint my head with oil; my cup overflows. (Psalm 23:4-5 CSB)

Stand & Resist > We are not fighting against human beings but against the wicked spiritual forces in the heavenly world, the rulers, authorities, and cosmic powers of this dark age. So put on God's armor now! Then when the evil day comes, you will be able to resist the enemy's attacks; and after fighting to the end, you will still hold your ground. (Ephesians 6:12-13 GNT)

Trust & Hope > See? The eye of the LORD is on those who fear Him, and on those who hope for His loving-kindness, to save their soul from death, and to keep them alive when there is nothing to eat. Our soul waits for the LORD. He is our help and our safe cover. For our heart is full of joy in Him, because we trust in His holy name. O LORD, let Your loving-kindness be upon us as we put our hope in You. (Psalm 33:18-22 NIV)

Trustworthy Protection > Yeshua said, "My sheep hear My voice. I know them, and they follow Me. I give them eternal life! They will never perish, and no one will snatch them out of My hand. My Father gave them to Me, and He is greater than all. No one is able to snatch them out of the Father's hand. (John 10:27-29 TLV)
