**Abba Father** > Because you are his sons, God sent the Spirit of his Son into our hearts, the Spirit who calls out, "Abba, Father." So you are no longer a slave, but God's child; and since you are his child, God has made you also an heir." (Galatians 4:6-7 NIV)

**Adonai** > Have you not known? Have you not heard? Adonai is the eternal God, the Creator of the ends of the earth. He does not grow tired or weary. His understanding is unsearchable. He gives strength to the weary, and to one without vigor He adds might. Even youths grow tired and weary, and young men stumble and fall, but they who wait for Adonai will renew their strength. They will soar up with wings as eagles. They will run, and not grow weary. They will walk, and not be faint. (Isaiah 40:28-31 TLV)

**Adonai Elohim** > Adonai Elohim made Adam and his wife tunics of skin and He clothed them. Then Adonai Elohim said, "Behold, the man has become like one of Us, knowing good and evil. So now, in case he stretches out his hand and takes also from the Tree of Life and eats and lives forever," Adonai Elohim sent him away from the Garden of Eden, to work the ground from which he had been taken. And He expelled the man; and at the east of the Garden of Eden He had cherubim dwell along, with the whirling sword of flame, to guard the way to the Tree of Life. (Genesis 3:21-24 TLV)

**Adoption Spirit** > For you did not receive a spirit of slavery to fall back into fear, but you received the Spirit of Adoption, by whom we cry out, “Abba, Father!” The Spirit himself testifies together with our spirit that we are God’s children, (Romans 8:15-16 HCSB)

**Advocate** > My dear children, I am writing this to you so that you will not sin. But if anyone does sin, we have an Advocate who pleads our case before the Father. He is Jesus Christ, the one who is truly righteous. (1 John 2:1 NLT)

**Alive Forever** > When I saw Him, I fell at His feet like a dead man. He laid his right hand on me and said, “Don’t be afraid! I am the First and the Last, and the Living One. I was dead, but look: I Am Alive Forever and ever, and I hold the keys of death and Hades.” (Revelation 1:17-18 HCSB)

**Almighty** > “I am the Alpha and the Omega,” says the Lord God, “who is, and who was, and who is to come, the Almighty.” (Revelation 1:7-8 NIV)

**Almighty God** > When Abram was 99 years old, the LORD appeared to him and said, “I am the Almighty God. Obey me and always do what is right. I will make my covenant with you and give you many descendants.” (Genesis 17:1-2 GNB)

**Almighty’s Breath** > My words come from an upright heart; my lips sincerely speak what I know. The Spirit of God has made me; the breath of the Almighty gives me life. (Job 33:3-4 NIV)

**Alpha & Omega** > “Look, I am coming soon, bringing my reward with me to repay all people according to their deeds. I am the Alpha and the Omega, the First

and the Last, the Beginning and the End.”

(Revelation 22:12-13 NLT)

**Ancient of Days** > While I was watching, thrones were set up, and the Ancient of Days took his seat. His garment was as white as snow, and the hair of His head like pure wool. His throne was ablaze with flames, its wheels a burning fire. A river of fire was flowing and coming out from before Him. Thousands of thousands attended Him and ten thousand times ten thousand stood before Him. The court was seated, and the books were opened. (Daniel 7:9-10 TLV)

**Angel of His Presence** > He said, “Surely they are my people, children who will be true to me”; and so he became their Savior. In all their distress he too was distressed, and the Angel of his presence saved them. In his love and mercy he redeemed them; he lifted them up and carried them all the days of old.

(Isaiah 63:8-9 NIV)

**Anointed One** > God anointed Jesus of Nazareth with the Holy Spirit and with power, and he went about doing good and healing all who were under the tyranny of the devil, because God was with him. We ourselves are witnesses of everything he did in both the Judean country and in Jerusalem, and yet they killed him by hanging him on a tree.

(Acts 10:38-39 NIV)

**Apostle** > Therefore, holy brothers and sisters, who share in the heavenly calling, fix your thoughts on Jesus, whom we acknowledge as our Apostle and High Priest. He was faithful to the one who appointed

him, just as Moses was faithful in all God's house.  
(Hebrews 3:1-2 NIV)

**Atoning Sacrifice** > This is how God showed his love among us: he sent his one and only Son into the world that we might live through him. This is love: not that we loved God, but that he loved us and sent his Son as an Atoning Sacrifice for our sins. (1 John 4:9-10 NIV)

**Author of Life** > This is the same Jesus whom you handed over and rejected before Pilate, despite Pilate's decision to release him. You rejected this Holy, Righteous One and instead demanded the release of a murderer. You killed the Author of Life, but God raised him from the dead. And we are witnesses of this fact! Through faith in the name of Jesus, this man was healed—and you know how crippled he was before. Faith in Jesus' name has healed him before your very eyes. (Acts 3:13-16 NLT)

**Banner for the Peoples** > None will harm or destroy another on my entire holy mountain, for the land will be as full of the knowledge of the LORD as the sea is filled with water. On that day the root of Jesse will stand as a Banner for the peoples. The nations will seek him, and his resting place will be glorious.  
(Isaiah 11:9-10 HCSB)

**Beginning & End** > I am the First and the Last, the Beginning and the End. Happy are those who wash

their robes clean and so have the right to eat from the fruit from the tree of life and to go through the gates into the city. (Revelation 22:13-14 GNB)

**Beloved Son** > After Jesus was baptized, he went up immediately from the water. The heavens suddenly opened for him, and he saw the Spirit of God descending like a dove and coming down on him. And there came a voice from heaven: “This is my Beloved Son. I take delight in him!” (Matthew 3:16-17 HCSB)

**Blazing Fire** > But who will be able to endure it when he comes? Who will be able to stand and face him when he appears? For he will be like a Blazing Fire that refines metal, or like a strong soap that bleaches clothes. (Malachi 3:2 NLT)

**Blessed Ruler** > God will bring about his will in his own time—God, the Blessed and only Ruler, the King of kings and Lord of lords, who alone is immortal and who lives in unapproachable light, whom no one has seen or can see. To him be honor and might forever. Amen. (1 Timothy 6:15-16 NIV)

**Bread of Life** > “I am the Bread of Life,” Jesus told them. “Those who come to me will never be hungry; those who believe in me will never be thirsty.” (John 6:35 GNB)

**Bridegroom** > Then John’s disciples came and asked him, “How is it that we and the Pharisees fast often, but your disciples do not fast?” Jesus answered, “How can the guests of the Bridegroom mourn while he is with them? The time will come when the Bridegroom will be taken from them; then they will fast.”

(Matthew 9:14-15 NIV)

**Bright Morning Star** > “I, Jesus, have sent my angel to attest these things to you for the churches. I am the Root and the Offspring of David, the Bright Morning Star.” Both the Spirit and the bride say, “Come!”

Anyone who hears should say, “Come!” And the one who is thirsty should come. Whoever desires should take the living water as a gift.

(Revelation 22:16-17 HCSB)

**Carpenter** > “Isn’t he the Carpenter, the son of Mary, and the brother of James, Joseph, Judas, and Simon? Aren’t his sisters living here?” And so they rejected him. Jesus said to them, “Prophets are respected everywhere except in their own home town and by their relatives and their family.” (Mark 6:3-4 GNB)

**Centerpiece** > So, my dear Christian friends, companions in following this call to the heights, take a good hard look at Jesus. He’s the Centerpiece of everything we believe, faithful in everything God gave him to do. Moses was also faithful, but Jesus gets far more honor. A builder is more valuable than a building any day. Every house has a builder, but the Builder behind them all is God. Moses did a good job in God’s house, but it was all servant work, getting things ready for what was to come. Christ as Son is in charge of the house. (Hebrews 3:1-6 MSG)

**Chain Breaker** > You were worn out from working like slaves, and no one came to help. You were in serious trouble, but you prayed to the LORD, and he rescued you. He brought you out of the deepest darkness and broke your chains. You should praise the LORD for his

love and for the wonderful things he does for all of us.  
(Psalm 107:12-15 CEV)

**Chief Cornerstone** > Consequently, you are no longer foreigners and strangers, but fellow citizens with God's people and also members of his household, built on the foundation of the apostles and prophets, with Christ Jesus himself as the Chief Cornerstone.  
(Ephesians 2:19-20 NIV)

**Chosen One** > This is my Servant; I strengthen him, this is my Chosen One; I delight in him. I have put my Spirit on him; he will bring justice to the nations.  
(Isaiah 42:1 HCSB)

**Christ** > Jesus said to them, "But who do you say that I am?" Simon Peter replied, "You are the Christ, the Son of the Living God." (Matthew 16:15-16 ESV)

**Christ Crucified** > But we preach Christ Crucified, a stumbling block to the Jews and foolishness to the Gentiles. Yet to those who are called, both Jews and Greeks, Christ is God's Power and God's Wisdom.  
(1 Corinthians 1:23-24 HCSB)

**Christ Jesus** > God raised us up together, and made us sit together in heavenly places in Christ Jesus, that in the ages to come he might show the exceeding riches of his grace in his kindness toward us in Christ Jesus. (Ephesians 2:6-7 NKJV)

**Consuming Fire** > Therefore, since we are receiving a kingdom that cannot be shaken, let us be thankful, and so worship God acceptably with reverence and awe, for our "God is a consuming fire."

(Hebrews 12:28-29 NIV)

**Cornerstone** > Jesus said to them, “Have you never read in the Scriptures: The Stone that the builders rejected has become the Cornerstone. This came from the LORD and is wonderful in our eyes? Therefore I tell you, the kingdom of God will be taken away from you and given to a nation producing its fruit.”  
(Matthew 21:42-43 HCSB)

**Covenant Messenger** > “Look! I am sending my messenger, and he will prepare the way before me. Then the LORD you are seeking will suddenly come to his Temple. The Messenger of the Covenant, whom you look for so eagerly, is surely coming,” says the LORD of Heaven’s Armies. (Malachi 3:1 NLT)

**Covenant to the People** > I, the LORD, have called you in righteousness, and will hold your hand; I will keep you and give you as a Covenant to the people, as a Light to the Gentiles, to open blind eyes, to bring out prisoners from prison, those who sit in darkness from the prison house. (Isaiah 42:6-7 NKJV)

**Crown of Glory** > In that day the LORD of hosts will be for a Crown of Glory and a Diadem of Beauty to the remnant of his people, for a Spirit of Justice to him who sits in judgement, and for strength to those who turn back the battle at the gate. (Isaiah 28:5-6 NKJV)

**Deliverer** > Let all who seek you rejoice and be glad in you; let those who love your salvation continually say, “The LORD is great!” I am afflicted and needy; the LORD thinks of me. You are my Helper and Deliverer; my God, do not delay. (Psalm 40:16-17 HCSB)

**Desire of All Nations** > For thus says the LORD of hosts: “Once more (it is a little while) I will shake heaven and earth, the sea and dry land; and I will shake all nations, and they shall come to the Desire of all Nations, and I will fill this temple with glory,” says the LORD of hosts. (Haggai 2:6-7 NKJV)

**Door** > Then Jesus said to them again, “Most assuredly, I say to you, I am the Door of the sheep. All who ever came before Me are thieves and robbers, but the sheep did not hear them. I am the Door. If anyone enters by Me, he will be saved, and will go in and out and find pasture. The thief does not come except to steal, and to kill, and to destroy. I have come that they may have life, and that they may have it more abundantly.” (John 10:7-10 NKJV)

**Dwelling Place** > LORD, you have been our Dwelling Place in all generations. Before the mountains were brought forth, or ever you had formed the earth and the world, from everlasting to everlasting you are God. (Psalm 90:1-2 ESV)

**Eternal Life** > We know that we are of God, and the whole world is under the sway of the evil one. And we know that the Son of God has come and has given us understanding so that we may know the true One. We are in the true One - that is, in his Son Jesus Christ. he is the True God and Eternal Life. (1 John 5:19-20 HCSB)

**Everlasting Father** > For to us a child is born, to us a son is given, and the government will be on his shoulders. And he will be called Wonderful Counselor, Mighty God, Everlasting Father, Prince of Peace. Of the

greatness of his government and peace there will be no end. He will reign on David's throne and over his kingdom, establishing and upholding it with justice and righteousness from that time on and forever. The zeal of the LORD Almighty will accomplish this.  
(Isaiah 9:6-7 NIV)

**Everlasting God** > Do you not know? Have you not heard? The LORD is the Everlasting God, the Creator of the ends of the earth. He will not grow tired or weary, and his understanding no one can fathom. He gives strength to the weary and increases the power of the weak. (Isaiah 40:28-29 NIV)

**Everlasting Light** > The sun shall be no more your light by day, nor for brightness shall the moon give you light; but the LORD will be your Everlasting Light, and your God will be your glory. Your sun shall no more go down, nor your moon withdraw itself; for the LORD will be your Everlasting Light, and your days of mourning shall be ended. (Isaiah 60:19-20 ESV)

**Faithful** > May God himself, the God of peace, sanctify you through and through. May your whole spirit, soul and body be kept blameless at the coming of our Lord Jesus Christ. The one who calls you is Faithful, and he will do it. (1 Thessalonians 5:23-24 NIV)

**Faithful & True** > Then I saw heaven opened, and a white horse was standing there. Its rider was named Faithful and True, for he judges fairly and wages a righteous war. His eyes were like flames of fire, and on his head were many crowns. A name was written on him that no one understood except himself.  
(Revelation 19:11-12 NLT)

**Father of Compassion** > Praise be to the God and Father of our Lord Jesus Christ, the Father of Compassion and the God of All Comfort, who comforts us in all our troubles, so that we can comfort those in any trouble with the comfort we ourselves receive from God. (2 Corinthians 2:3-4 NIV)

**Father of Glory** > May the God of our Lord Jesus Christ, the Father of Glory, give to you the Spirit of Wisdom and Revelation in the Knowledge of him, the eyes of your understanding being enlightened; that you may know what is the hope of his calling, what are the riches of the glory of his inheritance in the saints. (Ephesians 1:17-18 NKJV)

**Father of Lights** > Every generous act and every perfect gift is from above, coming down from the Father of Lights; with him there is no variation or shadow cast by turning. By his own choice, he gave us a new birth by the message of truth so that we would be the first fruits of his creatures. (James 1:17-18 HCSB)

**Father's Only Son** > They did not become God's children by natural means, that is, by being born as the children of a human father; God himself was their Father. The Word became a human being and, full of grace and truth, lived among us. We saw his glory, the glory which he received as the Father's Only Son. (John 1:13-14 GNB)

**First & Last** > When I saw him, I fell at his feet as if I were dead. But he laid his right hand on me and said, "Don't be afraid! I am the First and the Last. I am the Living One. I died, but look - I am Alive Forever and

ever! And I hold the keys of death and the grave.”  
(Revelation 1:17-18 NLT)

**Firstborn** > He is before all things, and in him all things hold together. And he is the Head of the Body, the Church; he is the Beginning and the Firstborn from among the dead, so that in everything he might have the supremacy. (Colossians 1:17-18 NIV)

**Fortress** > Let all that I am wait quietly before God, for my hope is in him. He alone is my Rock and my Salvation, my Fortress where I will not be shaken.  
(Psalm 62:5-6 NLT)

**Forerunner** > We have this hope as an anchor for our lives, safe and secure. It enters the inner sanctuary behind the curtain. Jesus has entered there on our behalf as a Forerunner, because he has become a High Priest forever in the order of Melchizedek.  
(Hebrews 6:19-20 HCSB)

**Foundation** > We are God’s workers, working together; you are like God’s farm, God’s house. Using the gift God gave me, I laid the foundation of that house like an expert builder. Others are building on that foundation, but all people should be careful how they build on it. The Foundation that has already been laid is Jesus Christ, and no one can lay down any other foundation. (1 Corinthians 3:9-11 NCV)

**Fountain of Water** > Jesus answered and said to her, “Whoever drinks of this water will thirst again, but whoever drinks of the water that I shall give him will never thirst. But the water that I shall give him will

become in him a Fountain of Water springing up into everlasting life.” (John 4:13-14 NKJV)

**Friend of Sinners** > The Son of Man came, eating and drinking, and people say, “Look at him! He eats too much and drinks too much wine, and he is a Friend of tax collectors and sinners.” But wisdom is proved to be right by what she does. (Matthew 11:19 NCV)

**Gate** > Jesus said, “Yes, I am the Gate. Those who come in through me will be saved. They will come and go freely and will find good pastures. The thief’s purpose is to steal and kill and destroy. My purpose is to give them a rich and satisfying life.” (John 10:9-10 NLT)

**Gift of God** > The Samaritan woman said to him, “How is it that you, a Jew, ask for a drink from me, a woman of Samaria?” (For Jews have no dealings with Samaritans.) Jesus answered her, “If you knew the Gift of God, and who it is that is saying to you, ‘Give me a drink,’ you would have asked him, and he would have given you Living Water.” (John 4:9-10 ESV)

**Glorious Sword** > So Israel will live in safety; Jacob will dwell secure in a land of grain and new wine, where the heavens drop dew. Blessed are you, Israel! Who is like you, a people saved by the LORD? He is your Shield and Helper and your Glorious Sword. Your enemies will cower before you, and you will tread on their heights. (Deuteronomy 33:28-29 NIV)

**Glory of Adonai** > Above the expanse over their heads was something like a throne, resembling a sapphire stone. Above the shape of the throne was a figure of

human appearance. From what appeared as his waist upward, I saw a glowing metal, looking like a fire encased in a frame. From what was like his waist down, I saw the appearance of fire radiating around him. Like the appearance of the rainbow in the cloud on a rainy day, so was the appearance of the radiance. It was the appearance of the likeness of the Glory of Adonai. I saw it, fell upon my face, and heard the voice of the One who was speaking. (Ezekiel 1:26-28 TLV)

**God** > “My Lord and my God!” Thomas exclaimed. Then Jesus told him, “You believe because you have seen me. Blessed are those who believe without seeing me.” (John 20:28-29 NLT)

**God of All Comfort** > Blessed be the God and Father of our Lord Jesus Christ, the Father of Mercies and God of All Comfort, who comforts us in all our tribulation, that we may be able to comfort those who are in any trouble, with the comfort with which we ourselves are comforted by God.  
(2 Corinthians 1:3-4 NKJV)

**God of All the Earth** > Fear not; you will no longer live in shame. Don't be afraid; there is no more disgrace for you. You will no longer remember the shame of your youth or the sorrows of widowhood. For your Creator will be your Husband; the LORD of Heaven's Armies is his name! He is your Redeemer, the Holy One of Israel, the God of All the Earth. (Isaiah 54:4-5 NLT)

**God of gods & Lord of kings** > Then King Nebuchadnezzar fell prostrate before Daniel and paid him honor and ordered that an offering and incense be presented to him. The king said to Daniel, “Surely your

God is the God of gods and the Lord of kings and a Revealer of Mysteries, for you were able to reveal this mystery.” (Daniel 2:46-47 NIV)

**God of Israel** > Large crowds came to him, bringing with them the lame, the blind, the crippled, the dumb, and many other sick people, whom they placed at Jesus’ feet; and he healed them. The people were amazed as they saw the dumb speaking, the crippled made whole, the lame walking, and the blind seeing; and they praised the God of Israel.  
(Matthew 15:30-31 GNB)

**God of My Salvation** > Yet I will rejoice in the LORD; I will take joy in the God of My Salvation. God, the LORD, is my Strength; he makes my feet like the deer’s; he makes me tread on my high places.  
(Habakkuk 3:18-19 ESV)

**God of Peace** > Now may the God of Peace - who brought up from the dead our Lord Jesus, the Great Shepherd of the sheep, and ratified an eternal covenant with his blood - may he equip you with all you need for doing his will. May he produce in you, through the power of Jesus Christ, every good thing that is pleasing to him. All glory to him forever and ever! Amen. (Hebrews 13:20-21 NLT)

**God Our Savior** > To him who is able to keep you from stumbling and to present you before his glorious presence without fault and with great joy— to the only God Our Savior be glory, majesty, power and authority, through Jesus Christ Our Lord, before all ages, now and forevermore! Amen. (Jude 1:24-25 NIV)

**God Who Sees Me** > Hagar called Adonai who was speaking to her, “You are the God Who Sees Me.” For she said, “Would I have gone here indeed looking for Him who looks after me?” That is why the well is named, the Well of the Living One Who Sees Me. (Genesis 16:13-14 TLV)

**God’s Chosen One** > Then John gave this testimony: “I saw the Spirit come down from heaven as a dove and remain on him. And I myself did not know him, but the One who sent me to baptize with water told me, ‘The man on whom you see the Spirit come down and remain is the One who will baptize with the Holy Spirit.’ I have seen and I testify that this is God’s Chosen One.” (John 1:32-34 NIV)

**God’s Holy Spirit** > Let everything you say be good and helpful, so that your words will be an encouragement to those who hear them. And do not bring sorrow to God’s Holy Spirit by the way you live. Remember, he has identified you as his own, guaranteeing that you will be saved on the day of redemption. (Ephesians 4:29-30 NLT)

**Good Shepherd** > Jesus said, “I am the Good Shepherd. I know My own sheep, and they know Me, as the Father knows Me, and I know the Father. I lay down My life for the sheep.” (John 10:14-15 HCSB)

**Good Spirit** > But in your great mercy you did not abandon them to die in the wilderness. The pillar of cloud still led them forward by day, and the pillar of fire showed them the way through the night. You sent your Good Spirit to instruct them, and you did not stop

giving them manna from heaven or water for their thirst. (Nehemiah 9:19-20 NLT)

**Great High Priest** > Therefore, since we have a Great High Priest who has ascended into heaven, Jesus the Son of God, let us hold firmly to the faith we profess. For we do not have a high priest who is unable to empathize with our weaknesses, but we have One who has been tempted in every way, just as we are - yet he did not sin. (Hebrews 4:14-15 NIV)

**Great King** > Oh, clap your hands, all you peoples! Shout to God with the voice of triumph! For the LORD Most High is awesome; He is a Great King over all the earth. (Psalm 47:1-2 NKJV)

**Great Physician** > Many people came to Jesus. They brought with them those who were not able to walk. They brought those who were not able to see. They brought those who were not able to hear or speak and many others. Then they put them at the feet of Jesus and He healed them. All the people wondered. They saw how those who could not speak were now talking. They saw how those who could not walk were now walking. They saw how those who could not see were now seeing, and they gave thanks to the God of the Jews. (Matthew 15:30-31 NLT)

**Great Prophet** > Then he stepped up to the coffin and touched it. When the pallbearers came to a halt, Jesus said to the corpse, "Young man, I say to you, arise and live!" Immediately, the young man moved, sat up, and spoke to those nearby. Jesus presented the son to his mother, alive! A tremendous sense of holy mystery swept over the crowd as they witnessed this miracle of

resurrection. They shouted praises to God, saying, “God himself has visited us to bless his people! A Great Prophet has appeared among us!”  
(Luke 7:14-16 TPT)

**Great Shepherd** > Now may the God of Peace - who brought up from the dead our Lord Jesus, the Great Shepherd of the sheep, and ratified an eternal covenant with his blood - may he equip you with all you need for doing his will. May he produce in you, through the power of Jesus Christ, every good thing that is pleasing to him. All glory to him forever and ever! Amen. (Hebrews 13:20-21 NLT)

**Guide** > For this is God, our God forever and ever; he will be our Guide even to death. (Psalm 48:14 NKJV)

**Guiding Light** > I, the LORD, have called you to demonstrate my righteousness. I will take you by the hand and guard you, and I will give you to my people, Israel, as a symbol of my covenant with them. And you will be a Light to guide the nations. You will open the eyes of the blind. You will free the captives from prison, releasing those who sit in dark dungeons.  
(Isaiah 42:6-7 NLT)

**Head of the Body** > He is before all things, and by Him all things hold together. He is also the Head of the Body, the Church; He is the Beginning, the Firstborn from the dead, so that He might come to have first place in everything. (Colossians 1:17-18 HCSB)

**Head of the Church** > He is the Head of the Body, which is the Church. Everything comes from him. He is the First One who was raised from the dead. So in all

things Jesus has first place. God was pleased for all of himself to live in Christ. And through Christ, God has brought all things back to himself again—things on earth and things in heaven. God made peace through the blood of Christ's death on the cross.

(Colossians 1:18-20 NCV)

**Head Over Every Power** > For in Christ all the fullness of the Deity lives in bodily form, and in Christ you have been brought to fullness. He is the Head over every power and authority. (Colossians 2:9-10 NIV)

**Healer** > And Moses cried to the LORD, and the LORD showed him a log, and he threw it into the water, and the water became sweet. There the LORD made for them a statute and a rule, and there he tested them, saying, "If you will diligently listen to the voice of the LORD your God, and do that which is right in his eyes, and give ear to his commandments and keep all his statutes, I will put none of the diseases on you that I put on the Egyptians, for I am the LORD, your Healer." (Exodus 15:25-26 ESV)

**Heaven's Living Bread** > Jesus said, "Anyone who eats the bread from heaven, however, will never die. I am the Living Bread that came down from heaven. Anyone who eats this bread will live forever; and this bread, which I will offer so the world may live, is my flesh." (John 6:50-51 NLT)

**Heir** > Long ago God spoke to the fathers by the prophets at different times and in different ways. In these last days, He has spoken to us by His Son. God has appointed Him Heir of all things and made the universe through Him. (Hebrews 1:1-2 HCSB)

**Helper** > Jesus said, "I tell you the truth: it is better for you that I go away, because if I do not go, the Helper will not come to you. But if I do go away, then I will send him to you. And when he comes, he will prove to the people of the world that they are wrong about sin and about what is right and about God's judgment."  
(John 16:7-8 GNT)

**Hiding Place** > Therefore let all the faithful pray to you while you may be found; surely the rising of the mighty waters will not reach them. You are my Hiding Place; you will protect me from trouble and surround me with songs of deliverance. (Psalm 32:6-7 NIV)

**High Priest** > And having been perfected, Jesus became the Author of eternal salvation to all who obey Him, called by God as High Priest "according to the order of Melchizedek." (Hebrews 5:9-10 NKJV)

**Highest** > Then Mary said to the angel, "How can this be, since I do not know a man?" And the angel answered and said to her, "The Holy Spirit will come upon you, and the power of the Highest will overshadow you; therefore, also, that Holy One who is to be born will be called the Son of God."  
(Luke 1:34-35 NKJV)

**Holy God of Israel** > Again and again they put God to the test and brought pain to the Holy God of Israel. They forgot his great power and the day when he saved them from their enemies. (Psalm 78:41-42 GNB)

**Holy One** > I am the LORD, your Holy One, the Creator of Israel, your King. This is what the LORD says. He is

the One who made a road through the sea and a path through rough waters. He is the One who defeated the chariots and horses and the mighty armies. They fell together and will never rise again. They were destroyed as a flame is put out. (Isaiah 43:15-17 NCV)

**Holy One of God** > “What do you have to do with us, Jesus of Nazareth? Have you come to destroy us? I know who you are—the Holy One of God!” Jesus rebuked him saying, “Be silent, and come out of him!” And the unclean spirit threw him into convulsions, shouted with a loud voice, and came out of him. They were all amazed, and so they began to ask each other: “What is this? A new teaching with authority! He commands even the unclean spirits, and they obey him.” (Mark 1:24-27 CSB)

**Holy Righteous One** > You rejected this Holy, Righteous One and instead demanded the release of a murderer. You killed the Author of Life, but God raised him from the dead. And we are witnesses of this fact! Through faith in the name of Jesus, this man was healed—and you know how crippled he was before. Faith in Jesus’ name has healed him before your very eyes. Friends, I realize that what you and your leaders did to Jesus was done in ignorance. (Acts 3:14-17 NLT)

**Holy Spirit** > And tongues, like flames of fire that were divided, appeared to them and rested on each one of them. Then they were all filled with the Holy Spirit and began to speak in different languages, as the Spirit gave them ability for speech. (Acts 2:3-4 HCSB)

**Hope of Glory** > To them God chose to make known how great among the Gentiles are the riches of the

glory of this mystery, which is Christ in you, the Hope of Glory. Him we proclaim, warning everyone and teaching everyone with all wisdom, that we may present everyone mature in Christ.

(Colossians 1:27-28 ESV)

**Hope of Israel** > You who are the Hope of Israel, our Savior in times of distress, why are you like a stranger in the land, like a traveler who stays only a night? Why are you like a man taken by surprise, like a warrior powerless to save? You are among us, LORD, and we bear your name; do not forsake us!

(Jeremiah 14:8-9 NIV)

**Horn of My Salvation** > I love you, O LORD, my Strength. The LORD is my Rock and my Fortress and my Deliverer, my God, my Rock, in whom I take refuge, my Shield, and the Horn of my Salvation, my Stronghold. (Psalm 18:1-2 ESV)

**Horn of Salvation** > “Blessed is the LORD God of Israel, for He has visited and redeemed His people, and has raised up a Horn of Salvation for us in the house of His servant David.” (Luke 1:68-69 NKJV)

**I AM** > Jesus said to them, “Truly, truly, I say to you, before Abraham was, I AM.” So they picked up stones to throw at him, but Jesus hid himself and went out of the temple. (John 8:58-59 ESV)

**I AM WHO I AM** > Then Moses asked God, “If I go to the Israelites and say to them: ‘The God of your fathers has sent me to you,’ and they ask me, ‘What is His name?’ What should I tell them?” God replied to

Moses, “I AM WHO I AM. This is what you are to say to the Israelites: I AM has sent me to you.”  
(Exodus 3:13-14 HCSB)

**Immanuel** > “She will bring forth a Son, and you shall call His name Jesus, for He will save His people from their sins.” So all this was done that it might be fulfilled which was spoken by the LORD through the prophet, saying: “Behold, the virgin shall be with child, and bear a Son, and they shall call His name Immanuel,” which is translated, “God with us.” (Matthew 1:21-23 NKJV)

**Impartial Judge** > Since you call on him as your Heavenly Father, the Impartial Judge who judges according to each one’s works, live each day with holy awe and reverence throughout your time on earth. For you know that your lives were ransomed once and for all from the empty and futile way of life handed down from generation to generation. It was not a ransom payment of silver and gold, which eventually perishes, but the precious blood of Christ, who like a spotless, unblemished lamb was sacrificed for us.  
(1 Peter 1:17-19 TPT)

**Innocent Man** > While Pilate was sitting in the judgment hall, his wife sent him a message: “Have nothing to do with that Innocent Man, because in a dream last night I suffered much on account of him.” The chief priests and the elders persuaded the crowd to ask Pilate to set Barabbas free and have Jesus put to death. (Matthew 27:19-20 GNB)

**Israel’s Consolation** > Now there was a man in Jerusalem, whose name was Simeon, and this man was righteous and devout, waiting for the Consolation

of Israel, and the Holy Spirit was upon him. And it had been revealed to him by the Holy Spirit that he would not see death before he had seen the LORD's Christ. (Luke 2:25-26 ESV)

**Israel's Keeper** > Behold, He who keeps Israel shall neither slumber nor sleep. The LORD is your Keeper; the LORD is your Shade at your right hand. (Psalm 121:4-5 NKJV)

**Jesus** > Jesus gave up his place with God and made himself nothing. He was born as a man and became like a servant. And when he was living as a man, he humbled himself and was fully obedient to God, even when that caused his death: death on a cross. So God raised him to the highest place. God made his name greater than every other name so that every knee will bow to the name of Jesus: everyone in heaven, on earth, and under the earth. And everyone will confess that Jesus Christ is Lord and bring glory to God the Father. (Philippians 2:7-11 NCV)

**Jesus Christ** > Let us give thanks to the God and Father of our Lord Jesus Christ! Because of his great mercy he gave us new life by raising Jesus Christ from death. This fills us with a living hope, and so we look forward to possessing the rich blessings that God keeps for his people. He keeps them for you in heaven, where they cannot decay or spoil or fade away. (1 Peter 1:3-4 GNB)

**Jesus Messiah** > Jesus did many other miraculous signs that his followers saw, which are not written in this book. But these are written so that you can believe

that Jesus is the Messiah, the Son of God. Then, by believing, you can have life through his name. (John 20:30-31 ERV)

**Jesus of Galilee** > Now Peter was sitting out in the courtyard, and a servant girl came to him. “You also were with Jesus of Galilee,” she said. But he denied it before them all. “I don’t know what you’re talking about,” he said. (Matthew 26:69-70 NIV)

**Jesus of Nazareth** > Philip found Nathanael and told him, “We have found the One Moses wrote about in the Law (and so did the prophets): Jesus the son of Joseph, from Nazareth!” “Can anything good come out of Nazareth?” Nathanael asked him. “Come and see,” Philip answered. (John 1:45-46 HCSB)

**Judge** > Then I saw a great white throne and One seated on it. Earth and heaven fled from his presence, and no place was found for them. I also saw the dead, the great and the small, standing before the throne, and books were opened. Another book was opened, which is the book of life, and the dead were judged according to their works by what was written in the books. Then the sea gave up the dead that were in it, and death and Hades gave up the dead that were in them; each one was judged according to their works. (Revelation 20:11-13 CSB)

**Judge of the Living & Dead** > He commanded us to preach to the people and to solemnly testify that He is the One Appointed by God to be the Judge of the Living and the Dead. All the prophets testify about Him that through His name everyone who believes in Him will receive forgiveness of sins. (Acts 10:42-43 HCSB)

**King** > All nations will remember the LORD. From every part of the world they will turn to him; all races will worship him. The LORD is King, and he rules the nations. (Psalm 22:27-28 GNB)

**King David's Descendant** > Always remember that Jesus Christ, a Descendant of King David, was raised from the dead. This is the Good News I preach. And because I preach this Good News, I am suffering and have been chained like a criminal. But the Word of God cannot be chained. (2 Timothy 2:8-9 NLT)

**King Eternal Immortal Invisible** > But for that very reason I was shown mercy so that in me, the worst of sinners, Christ Jesus might display his immense patience as an example for those who would believe in him and receive eternal life. Now to the King Eternal, Immortal, Invisible, the Only God, be honor and glory for ever and ever. Amen. (1 Timothy 1:16-17 NIV)

**King of Angels** > This was a prophetic picture of the immersion that now saves you—not a bathing of the physical body but rather the response of a good conscience before God through the resurrection of Jesus Christ, who is now in heaven at the place of supreme authority next to God. The very powers of heaven, including every angel and authority, now yield in submission to him. (1 Peter 3:21-22 TPT)

**King of Glory** > Lift up your heads, O you gates! And be lifted up, you everlasting doors! And the King of Glory shall come in. Who is this King of Glory? The LORD strong and mighty, the LORD mighty in battle. (Psalm 24:7-8 NKJV)

**King of Kings & Lord of Lords** > Out of his mouth came a sharp sword, with which he will defeat the nations. He will rule over them with a rod of iron, and he will trample out the wine in the winepress of the furious anger of the Almighty God. On his robe and on his thigh was written the name: “King of kings and Lord of lords”. (Revelation 19:15-16 GNB)

**King of Old** > Yet God my King is from of Old, working salvation in the midst of the earth. You divided the sea by your might; you broke the heads of the sea monsters on the waters. (Psalm 74:12-13 ESV)

**King of Nations** > LORD, there is no one like you! For you are great, and your name is full of power. Who would not fear you, O King of Nations? That title belongs to you alone! Among all the wise people of the earth and in all the kingdoms of the world, there is no one like you. (Jeremiah 10:6-7 NLT)

**King of the Nations** > I also saw something like a sea of glass mixed with fire, and those who had won the victory over the beast, his image, and the number of his name, were standing on the sea of glass with harps from God. They sang the song of God’s servant Moses and the song of the Lamb: “Great and awe-inspiring are Your works, LORD God, the Almighty; righteous and true are Your ways, King of the Nations.” (Revelation 15:2-3 HCSB)

**King of the Jews** > Meanwhile Jesus stood before the governor, and the governor asked him, “Are you the King of the Jews?” “You have said so,” Jesus replied. (Matthew 27:11 NIV)

**King Who Comes in the Name of the LORD** > When Jesus reached the place where the road started down the Mount of Olives, all of his followers began to shout and sing as they walked along, praising God for all the wonderful miracles they had seen. “Blessings on the King Who Comes in the Name of the LORD! Peace in heaven, and glory in highest heaven!”  
(Luke 19:37-38 NLT)

**Lamb** > Then I looked and heard the voice of many angels, numbering thousands upon thousands, and ten thousand times ten thousand. They encircled the throne and the living creatures and the elders. In a loud voice they were saying: “Worthy is the Lamb, who was slain, to receive power and wealth and wisdom and strength and honor and glory and praise!”  
(Revelation 5:11-12 NIV)

**Lamb of God** > The next day John saw Jesus coming toward him and said, “Look, the Lamb of God, who takes away the sin of the world! This is the One I meant when I said, ‘A Man who comes after me has surpassed me because he was before me.’ I myself did not know him, but the reason I came baptizing with water was that he might be revealed to Israel.”  
(John 1:29-31 NIV)

**Leader & Commander of Nations** > I made him a Leader and Commander of Nations, and through him I showed them my power. Now you will summon foreign nations; at one time they did not know you, but now they will come running to join you! I, the LORD your God, the Holy God of Israel, will make all this happen; I will give you honor and glory. (Isaiah 55:4-5 GNB)

**Life** > For you have died, and your life is hidden with Christ in God. When Christ who is your Life appears, then you also will appear with him in glory.  
(Colossians 3:3-4 ESV)

**Light** > The Word gave life to everything that was created, and his life brought light to everyone. The Light shines in the darkness, and the darkness can never extinguish it. (John 1:4-5 NLT)

**Light in the Darkness** > If I say, "Let the darkness hide me and let the Light around me turn into night," even the darkness is not too dark for you. Night is as bright as day. Darkness and light are the same to you.  
(Psalm 139:11-12 GWT)

**Light of the World** > Then Jesus spoke to them again, saying, "I am the Light of the World. He who follows Me shall not walk in darkness, but have the Light of Life." (John 8:12 NKJV)

**Lion from Judah's Tribe** > I cried bitterly because no one could be found who was worthy to open the scroll or look inside it. Then one of the elders said to me, "Don't cry. Look! The Lion from Judah's Tribe, the Great Descendant of David, has won the victory, and he can break the seven seals and open the scroll."  
(Revelation 5:4-5 GNB)

**Living God** > King Darius published this proclamation to every race, color, and creed on earth: "Peace to you! Abundant peace! I decree that Daniel's God shall be worshiped and feared in all parts of my kingdom. He is the Living God, world without end. His kingdom never falls. His rule continues eternally. He is a Savior and

Rescuer. He performs astonishing miracles in heaven and on earth. He saved Daniel from the power of the lions.” (Daniel 6:25-27 MSG)

**Living One** > When I saw Him, I fell at His feet like a dead man. He laid His right hand on me and said, “Don’t be afraid! I am the First and the Last, and the Living One. I was dead, but look - I Am Alive Forever and ever, and I hold the keys of death and Hades.” (Revelation 1:17-18 HCSB)

**Living Stone** > As you come to him, the Living Stone - rejected by humans but chosen by God and precious to him - you also, like living stones, are being built into a spiritual house to be a holy priesthood, offering spiritual sacrifices acceptable to God through Jesus Christ. (1 Peter 2:4-5 NIV)

**Living Water** > Jesus answered and said to her, “If you knew the Gift of God, and who it is who says to you, ‘Give Me a drink,’ you would have asked Him, and He would have given you Living Water.” The woman said to Him, “Sir, You have nothing to draw with, and the well is deep. Where then do You get that living water?” (John 4:10-11 NKJV)

**LORD** > I AM the LORD your God who brought you out of Egypt, where you were slaves. Worship no god but me. Do not make for yourselves images of anything in heaven or on earth or in the water under the earth. Do not bow down to any idol or worship it, because I am the LORD your God, and I tolerate no rivals. I bring punishment on those who hate me and on their descendants down to the third and fourth generation.

But I show my love to thousands of generations of those who love me and obey my laws.  
(Exodus 20:2-6 GNB)

**Lord** > We thank God! He gives us the victory through our Lord Jesus Christ. So my dear brothers and sisters, stand strong. Do not let anything move you. Always give yourselves fully to the work of the Lord, because you know that your work in the Lord is never wasted.  
(1 Corinthians 15:57-58 NCV)

**LORD God Almighty** > They sang the song of God's servant Moses and the Song of the Lamb: "Great and awe-inspiring are your works, LORD God the Almighty; righteous and true are your ways, King of the Nations. LORD, who will not fear and glorify your name? Because you alone are holy, for all the nations will come and worship before you because your righteous acts have been revealed." (Revelation 15:3-4 HCSB)

**LORD God of Israel** > Then Solomon stood before the altar of the LORD in front of the whole assembly of Israel, spread out his hands toward heaven and said: "LORD, the God of Israel, there is no God like you in heaven above or on the earth below - you who keep your covenant of love with your servants who continue wholeheartedly in your way." (1 Kings 8:22-23 NIV)

**Lord Jesus** > For I am convinced that neither death nor life, neither angels nor demons, neither the present nor the future, nor any powers, neither height nor depth, nor anything else in all creation, will be able to separate us from the love of God that is in Christ Jesus our Lord. (Romans 8:38-39 NIV)

**Lord Jesus Christ** > We did not follow cleverly contrived myths when we made known to you the power and coming of our Lord Jesus Christ; instead, we were eyewitnesses of his majesty. For he received honor and glory from God the Father when the voice came to him from the Majestic Glory, saying “This is my Beloved Son, with whom I am well-pleased!” We ourselves heard this voice when it came from heaven while we were with him on the holy mountain.  
(2 Peter 1:16-18 CSB)

**LORD of Heaven’s Armies** > “On that day a Fountain will be opened for the dynasty of David and for the people of Jerusalem, a Fountain to cleanse them from all their sins and impurity. And on that day,” says the LORD of Heaven’s Armies, “I will erase idol worship throughout the land, so that even the names of the idols will be forgotten. I will remove from the land both the false prophets and the spirit of impurity that came with them.” (Zechariah 13:1-2 NLT)

**LORD of Hosts** > And one seraphim called to another and said: “Holy, holy, holy is the LORD of Hosts; the whole earth is full of his glory!” And the foundations of the thresholds shook at the voice of him who called, and the house was filled with smoke. And I said: “Woe is me! For I am lost; for I am a man of unclean lips, and I dwell in the midst of a people of unclean lips; for my eyes have seen the King, the LORD of Hosts!”  
(Isaiah 6:3-5 ESV)

**Lord of the Harvest** > Jesus said to his disciples, “The harvest is plentiful, but the laborers are few; therefore pray earnestly to the Lord of the Harvest to send out laborers into his harvest.” (Matthew 9:37-38 ESV)

**Lord of the Living & Dead** > If we live, it's to honor the Lord. And if we die, it's to honor the Lord. So whether we live or die, we belong to the Lord. Christ died and rose again for this very purpose: to be Lord both of the Living and of the Dead. (Romans 14:8-9 NLT)

**Lord of the Sabbath** > Jesus said to them, "The Sabbath was made for man, not man for the Sabbath. So the Son of Man is Lord even of the Sabbath."  
(Mark 2:27-28 ESV)

**Lord of All** > For there is no difference between Jew and Gentile - the same Lord is Lord of All and richly blesses all who call on him, for, "Everyone who calls on the name of the Lord will be saved."  
(Romans 10:12-13 NIV)

**Majesty on High** > In these last days, God has spoken to us by his Son, whom he appointed the Heir of all things, through whom also he created the world. He is the Radiance of the glory of God and the exact imprint of his nature, and he upholds the universe by the word of his power. After making purification for sins, he sat down at the right hand of the Majesty on High, having become as much superior to angels as the name he has inherited is more excellent than theirs.  
(Hebrews 1:2-4 ESV)

**Maker** > Does a clay pot dare argue with its Maker, a pot that is like all the others? Does the clay ask the Potter what he is doing? Does the pot complain that its Maker has no skill? Do we dare say to our parents, "Why did you make me like this?" The LORD, the Holy God of Israel, the One who shapes the future, says:

“You have no right to question me about my children or to tell me what I ought to do! I am the One who made the earth and created human beings to live there. By my power I stretched out the heavens; I control the sun, the moon, and the stars.”  
(Isaiah 45:9-12 GNT)

**Man of Sorrows** > He was despised and rejected - a Man of Sorrows, acquainted with deepest grief. We turned our backs on him and looked the other way. He was despised, and we did not care. Yet it was our weaknesses he carried; it was our sorrows that weighed him down. And we thought his troubles were a punishment from God, a punishment for his own sins!  
(Isaiah 53:3-4 NLT)

**Master** > After washing their feet, Jesus put on his robe again, sat down, and asked, “Do you understand what I was doing? You call me ‘Master’ and ‘Lord,’ and you do well to say it, for it is true. And since I, the Lord and Teacher, have washed your feet, you ought to wash each other’s feet. I have given you an example to follow: do as I have done to you. How true it is that a servant is not greater than his Master. Nor is the messenger more important than the One who sends him. You know these things—now do them! That is the path of blessing. (John 13:12-17 TLB)

**Mediator** > God our Savior who wants everyone to be saved and to understand the truth. For, there is one God and one Mediator who can reconcile God and humanity—the man Christ Jesus. He gave his life to purchase freedom for everyone. This is the message God gave to the world at just the right time.  
(1 Timothy 2:4-6 NLT)

**Messiah** > “A time is coming and has now come when the true worshipers will worship the Father in the Spirit and in Truth, for they are the kind of worshipers the Father seeks. God is Spirit, and his worshipers must worship in the Spirit and in Truth.” The woman said, “I know that Messiah” (called Christ) “is coming. When he comes, he will explain everything to us.” Then Jesus declared, “I, the One speaking to you—I am He.” (John 4:23-26 NIV)

**Mighty Warrior** > Mighty Warrior, strap your sword at your side. In your majesty and splendor—in your splendor ride triumphantly in the cause of truth, humility, and justice. May your right hand show your awe-inspiring acts. Your arrows pierce the hearts of the king’s enemies; the peoples fall under you. Your throne, God, is forever and ever; the scepter of Your kingdom is a scepter of justice. (Psalm 45:3-6 HCSB)

**Miracle Worker** > At that very time Jesus healed many people from their sicknesses, diseases, and evil spirits, and gave sight to many blind people. He answered John's messengers, “Go back and tell John what you have seen and heard: the blind can see, the lame can walk, those who suffer from dreaded skin diseases are made clean, the deaf can hear, the dead are raised to life, and the Good News is preached to the poor. How happy are those who have no doubts about me!” (Luke 8:21-23 GNT)

**Most High** > He parted the heavens and came down; dark clouds were under his feet. He mounted the cherubim and flew; he soared on the wings of the wind. He made darkness his canopy around him—the dark rain clouds of the sky. Out of the brightness of his

presence bolts of lightning blazed forth. The LORD thundered from heaven; the voice of the Most High resounded. (2 Samuel 22:10-14 NIV)

**My Banner** > Later, when Moses' arms became tired, the men put a large rock under him, and he sat on it. Then Aaron and Hur held up Moses' hands—Aaron on one side and Hur on the other. They kept his hands steady until the sun went down. So Joshua defeated the Amalekites in this battle. Then the LORD said to Moses, "Write about this battle in a book so people will remember. And be sure to tell Joshua, because I will completely destroy the Amalekites from the earth." Then Moses built an altar and named it "The LORD Is My Banner." (Exodus 17:12-15 NCV)

**My God** > A week later Jesus' disciples were again in the house, and Thomas was with them. Even though the doors were locked, Jesus stood among them and said, "Peace be with you!" Then Jesus said to Thomas, "Put your finger here, and look at my hands. Take your hand, and put it into my side. Stop doubting, and believe." Thomas responded to Jesus, "My Lord and My God!" Jesus said to Thomas, "You believe because you've seen me. Blessed are those who haven't seen me but believe." (John 20:26-29 GWT)

**My Provider** > Abraham lifted his eyes and looked, and there behind him was a ram caught in a thicket by its horns. So Abraham went and took the ram, and offered it up for a burnt offering instead of his son. And Abraham called the name of the place, "The LORD Will Provide"; as it is said to this day, "In the Mount of the LORD it shall be provided." (Genesis 22:13-14 NKJV)

**My Savior** > But as for me, I watch in hope for the LORD, I wait for God, My Savior; My God will hear me. (Micah 7:7 NIV)

**My Song** > “I will praise you, O LORD! You were angry with me, but not any more. Now you comfort me. See, God has come to save me. I will trust in him and not be afraid. The LORD God is My Strength and My Song; he has given me victory.” With joy you will drink deeply from the Fountain of Salvation! (Isaiah 12:1-3 NLT)

**New Spirit** > I will sprinkle clean water on you, and you will be clean. Your filth will be washed away, and you will no longer worship idols. And I will give you a new heart, and I will put a New Spirit in you. I will take out your stony, stubborn heart and give you a tender, responsive heart. (Ezekiel 36:25-26 NLT)

**New Wine** > Jesus said, “No one puts a piece of unshrunk cloth on an old garment, for the patch tears away from the garment, and a worse tear is made. Neither is New Wine put into old wineskins. If it is, the skins burst and the wine is spilled and the skins are destroyed. But New Wine is put into fresh wineskins, and so both are preserved.” (Matthew 9:16-17 ESV)

**One Who Calls You** > May God himself, the God of Peace, sanctify you through and through. May your whole spirit, soul and body be kept blameless at the coming of our Lord Jesus Christ. The One Who Calls You is faithful, and he will do it. (1 Thessalonians 5:23-24 NIV)

**Only Son** > Jesus said, “As Moses lifted up the bronze snake on a pole in the desert, in the same way the Son

of Man must be lifted up, so that everyone who believes in him may have eternal life. For God loved the world so much that he gave his Only Son, so that everyone who believes in him may not die but have eternal life. For God did not send his Son into the world to be its Judge, but to be its Savior.”

(John 3:14-17 GNT)

**Open Door** > Write to the angel of the church in Philadelphia: The Holy One, the True One, the One who has the Key of David, who opens and no one will close, and closes and no one opens says: “I know your works. Because you have limited strength, have kept My Word, and have not denied My Name. Look! I have placed before you an Open Door that no one is able to close.” (Revelation 3:7-8 HCSB)

**Pioneer & Perfector of Faith** > Therefore, since we are surrounded by such a great cloud of witnesses, let us throw off everything that hinders and the sin that so easily entangles. And let us run with perseverance the race marked out for us, fixing our eyes on Jesus, the Pioneer and Perfector of Faith. For the joy set before him he endured the cross, scorning its shame, and sat down at the right hand of the throne of God. (Hebrews 12:1-2 NIV)

**Potter** > And yet, O LORD, you are our Father. We are the clay, and you are the Potter. We all are formed by your hand. Don't be so angry with us, LORD. Please don't remember our sins forever. Look at us, we pray, and see that we are all your people. (Isaiah 64:8-9 NLT)

**Power & Wisdom of God** > But for those whom God has called, both Jews and Gentiles, this Message is

Christ, who is the Power of God and the Wisdom of God. For what seems to be God's foolishness is wiser than human wisdom, and what seems to be God's weakness is stronger than human strength.

(1 Corinthians 1:24-25 GNB)

**Prince & Savior** > The God of Our Ancestors brought Jesus back to life again after you had killed him by hanging him on a cross. Then, with mighty power, God exalted him to be a Prince and Savior, so that the people of Israel would have an opportunity for repentance, and for their sins to be forgiven. And we are witnesses of these things and so is the Holy Spirit, who is given by God to all who obey him.

(Acts 5:30-32 TLB)

**Prince of Peace** > For to us a child is born, to us a Son is given, and the government will be on his shoulders. And he will be called Wonderful Counselor, Mighty God, Everlasting Father, Prince of Peace. Of the greatness of his government and peace there will be no end. He will reign on David's throne and over his kingdom, establishing and upholding it with justice and righteousness from that time on and forever. The zeal of the LORD Almighty will accomplish this.

(Isaiah 9:6-7 NIV)

**Promise Keeper** > Your kingdom will never end, and you will rule forever. The LORD can be trusted in all that he says. He is loyal in all that he does. The LORD lifts up people who have fallen. He helps those who are in trouble. All living things look to you for their food, and you give them their food at the right time. You open your hands and give every living thing all that it needs. (Psalm 145:13-16 ERV)

**Promised Holy Spirit** > When you heard the Message of Truth, the Gospel of Your Salvation, and when you believed in Him, you were also sealed with the Promised Holy Spirit. He is the down payment of our inheritance, for the redemption of the possession, to the praise of His glory. (Ephesians 1:13-14 HCSB)

**Protective Shade** > The LORD himself watches over you! The LORD stands beside you as your Protective Shade. The sun will not harm you by day, nor the moon at night. (Psalm 121:5-6 NLT)

**Rabbi** > Nicodemus came to Jesus at night and said, “Rabbi, we know that you are a Teacher who has come from God. For no one could perform the signs you are doing if God were not with him.” Jesus replied, “Very truly I tell you, no one can see the kingdom of God unless they are born again.” (John 3:2-3 NIV)

**Rabboni** > Jesus said to her, “Mary!” She turned and said to him, “Rabboni.” (The Aramaic word “Rabboni” means “Teacher.”) Jesus told her, “Don’t hold on to me! I have not yet gone to the Father. But tell my disciples that I am going to the One who is My Father and My God, as well as your Father and your God.” Mary Magdalene then went and told the disciples that she had seen the Lord. She also told them what he had said to her. (John 20:16-18 CEV)

**Radiant Glory** > As Jesus prayed, his face began to glow until it was a blinding glory streaming from him. His entire body was illuminated with a Radiant Glory. His brightness became so intense that it made his clothing blinding white, like multiple flashes of lightning. All at once, two men appeared in glorious

splendor: Moses and Elijah. They spoke with Jesus about his soon departure from this world and the things he was destined to accomplish in Jerusalem. (Luke 9:29-31 TPT)

**Ransom** > Jesus said, “Whoever wants to become great among you must serve the rest of you like a servant. Whoever wants to become first among you must serve the rest of you like a slave. In the same way, the Son of Man did not come to be served. He came to serve others and to give his life as a Ransom for many people.” (Matthew 20:26-28 NCV)

**Redeemer** > “The Redeemer will come to Zion, and to those who turn from transgression in Jacob,” says the LORD. “As for me,” says the LORD, “this is My Covenant with them: My Spirit who is upon you, and my words which I have put in your mouth, shall not depart from your mouth, nor from the mouth of your descendants, nor from the mouth of your descendants’ descendants,” says the LORD, “from this time and forevermore.” (Isaiah 59:20-21 NKJV)

**Refiner’s Fire** > But who can endure the day of his coming? Who can stand when he appears? For he will be like a Refiner’s Fire or a Launderer’s Soap. He will sit as a Refiner and Purifier of silver; he will purify the Levites and refine them like gold and silver. Then the LORD will have men who will bring offerings in righteousness, and the offerings of Judah and Jerusalem will be acceptable to the LORD, as in days gone by, as in former years. (Malachi 3:2-4 NIV)

**Refuge** > You have been a Stronghold for the poor person, a Stronghold for the needy in his distress, a

Refuge from storms and a Shade from heat. When the breath of the violent is like a storm against a wall, like heat in a dry land, you will subdue the uproar of barbarians. As the shade of a cloud cools the heat of the day, so he will silence the song of the violent. (Deuteronomy 33:26-27 NIV)

**Resurrection and the Life** > Jesus said to her, “I am the Resurrection and the Life. He who believes in me, though he may die, he shall live. And whoever lives and believes in me shall never die. Do you believe this?” (John 11:25-26 NKJV)

**Revealer of Mysteries** > Blessed be the name of God forever and ever, for he alone has all wisdom and all power. World events are under his control. He removes kings and sets others on their thrones. He gives wise men their wisdom and scholars their intelligence. He reveals profound mysteries beyond man’s understanding. He knows all hidden things, for he is Light, and darkness is no obstacle to him. I thank and praise you, O God of My Fathers, for you have given me wisdom and glowing health, and now even this vision of the king’s dream and the understanding of what it means. (Daniel 2:20-23 TLB)

**Righteous One** > I am writing this to you, my children, so that you will not sin; but if anyone does sin, we have someone who pleads with the Father on our behalf - Jesus Christ, the Righteous One. And Christ himself is the means by which our sins are forgiven, and not our sins only, but also the sins of everyone. (1 John 2:1-2 GNB)

**Righteous Servant** > But it was the LORD's good plan to crush him and cause him grief. Yet when his life is made an offering for sin, he will have many descendants. He will enjoy a long life, and the LORD's good plan will prosper in his hands. When he sees all that is accomplished by his anguish, he will be satisfied. And because of his experience, My Righteous Servant will make it possible for many to be counted righteous, for he will bear all their sins. (Isaiah 53:10-11 NLT)

**Rising Sun** > You will be called a prophet of the Most High; for you will go on before the Lord to prepare the way for him, to give his people the knowledge of salvation through the forgiveness of their sins, because of the tender mercy of our God, by which the Rising Sun will come to us from heaven to shine on those living in darkness and in the shadow of death, to guide our feet into the path of peace. (Luke 1:78-79 NIV)

**Rock of Israel** > The LORD's Spirit spoke through me, and his word was on my tongue. The God of Israel spoke; the Rock of Israel said to me: "Whoever rules fairly over people, who rules with respect for God, is like the morning light at dawn, like a morning without clouds. He is like sunshine after a rain that makes the grass sprout from the ground." (2 Samuel 23:2-4 NCV)

**Ruler Over the Earth's Kings** > Grace to you and peace from him who is and who was and who is to come, and from the seven spirits who are before his throne, and from Jesus Christ, the Faithful Witness, the Firstborn from the dead, and the Ruler over the kings of the earth. To him who loved us and washed us from

our sins in his own blood, and has made us kings and priests to his God and Father, to him be glory and dominion forever and ever. Amen. Behold, he is coming with clouds, and every eye will see him, even they who pierced him. And all the tribes of the earth will mourn because of him. Even so, Amen.

(Revelation 1:4-6 NKJV)

**Savior** > For we continue to look forward to the joyful fulfillment of our hope in the dawning splendor of the glory of our Great God and Savior, Jesus, the Anointed One. He sacrificed himself for us that he might purchase our freedom from every lawless deed and to purify for himself a people who are his very own, passionate to do what is beautiful in his eyes.

(Titus 2:13-14 TPT)

**Shelter & Strength** > God is our Shelter and Strength, always ready to help in times of trouble. So we will not be afraid, even if the earth is shaken and mountains fall into the ocean depths. (Psalm 46:1-2 GNB)

**Shepherd** > The LORD is my Shepherd; I shall not want. He makes me lie down in green pastures. He leads me beside still waters. He restores my soul. He leads me in paths of righteousness for his name's sake. (Psalm 23:1-3 ESV)

**Shepherd & Overseer** > Christ suffered for us, leaving us an example, that you should follow his steps: "Who committed no sin, nor was deceit found in his mouth"; who, when he was reviled, did not revile in return; when he suffered, he did not threaten, but committed himself to God Who Judges Righteously; who himself bore our sins in his own body on the tree, that we,

having died to sins, might live for righteousness—by whose stripes you were healed. For you were like sheep going astray, but have now returned to the Shepherd and Overseer of your souls.

(1 Peter 2:21-25 NKJV)

**Shield** > God's way is perfect. All the LORD's promises prove true. He is a Shield for all who look to him for protection. For who is God except the LORD? Who but our God is a Solid Rock? (Psalm 18:30-31 NLT)

**Shield & Rampart** > Surely he will save you from the fowler's snare and from the deadly pestilence. He will cover you with his feathers, and under his wings you will find refuge; his faithfulness will be your Shield and Rampart. (Psalm 91:3-4 NIV)

**Skilled Master Builder** > According to God's grace that was given to me, I have laid a foundation as a Skilled Master Builder, and another builds on it. But each one must be careful how he builds on it. For no one can lay any other foundation than what has been laid down. That Foundation is Jesus Christ.  
(1 Corinthians 3:10-11 HCSB)

**Sky Painter** > The heavens tell about the glory of God. The skies announce what his hands have made. Each new day tells more of the story, and each night reveals more and more about God's power. You cannot hear them say anything. They don't make any sound we can hear. But their message goes throughout the world. Their teaching reaches the ends of the earth. The sun's tent is set up in the heavens. (Psalm 19:1-4 ERV)

**Son** > The Son is the Image of the Invisible God, the Firstborn over all creation. For in him all things were created: things in heaven and on earth, visible and invisible, whether thrones or powers or rulers or authorities; all things have been created through him and for him. (Colossians 1:15-16 NIV)

**Son of God** > Jesus again gave a loud cry and breathed his last. Then the curtain hanging in the Temple was torn in two from top to bottom. The earth shook, the rocks split apart, the graves broke open, and many of God's people who had died were raised to life. They left the graves, and after Jesus rose from death, they went into the Holy City, where many people saw them. When the army officer and the soldiers with him who were watching Jesus saw the earthquake and everything else that happened, they were terrified and said, "He really was the Son of God!" (Matthew 27:50-54 GNT)

**Son of Man** > I was watching in the night visions. Behold, One like a Son of Man, coming with the clouds of heaven. He approached the Ancient of Days, and was brought into His presence. Dominion, glory and sovereignty were given to Him that all peoples, nations, and languages should serve Him. His dominion is an everlasting dominion that will never pass away, and His kingdom is one that will not be destroyed. (Daniel 7:13-14 TLV)

**Source of Peace** > May the Lord himself, who is the Source of Peace, give you peace at all times and in every way. The Lord be with you all.  
(2 Thessalonians 3:16 GNB)

**Source of Salvation** > But we do see Jesus - made lower than the angels for a short time so that by God's grace he might taste death for everyone - crowned with glory and honor because of his suffering in death. For in bringing many sons to glory, it was entirely appropriate that God - all things exist for him and through him - should make the Source of their salvation perfect through sufferings.  
(Hebrews 2:9-10 HCSB)

**Spirit** > Where can I go to get away from your Spirit? Where can I run to get away from you? If I go up to heaven, you are there. If I make my bed in Sheol, you are there. If I climb upward on the rays of the morning sun or land on the most distant shore of the sea where the sun sets, even there your hand would guide me and your right hand would hold on to me.  
(Psalm 139:7-10 GWT)

**Spirit of Christ** > You, however, are not in the flesh but in the Spirit, if in fact the Spirit of God dwells in you. Anyone who does not have the Spirit of Christ does not belong to him. But if Christ is in you, although the body is dead because of sin, the Spirit is Life because of righteousness. (Romans 8:9-10 ESV)

**Spirit of Counsel & Might** > A Shoot will come up from the stump of Jesse; from his roots a Branch will bear fruit. The Spirit of the LORD will rest on him - the Spirit of Wisdom and Understanding, the Spirit of Counsel and Might, the Spirit of the Knowledge and Fear of the LORD. (Isaiah 11:1-2 NIV)

**Spirit of Faith** > At all times we carry in our mortal bodies the death of Jesus, so that his life also may be

seen in our bodies. Throughout our lives we are always in danger of death for Jesus' sake, in order that his life may be seen in this mortal body of ours. This means that death is at work in us, but life is at work in you. The Scripture says, "I spoke because I believed." In the same Spirit of Faith, we also speak, because we believe. (2 Corinthians 4:10-13 GNT)

**Spirit of Glory** > Beloved, do not think it strange concerning the fiery trial which is to test you, as though some strange thing happened to you; but rejoice to the extent that you partake of Christ's sufferings, that when his glory is revealed, you may also be glad with exceeding joy. If you are insulted for the name of Christ, blessed are you, for the Spirit of Glory and of God rests upon you. (1 Peter 4:12-14 NKJV)

**Spirit of God** > Who knows a person's thoughts except his spirit within him? In the same way, no one knows the thoughts of God except the Spirit of God. Now we have not received the spirit of the world, but the Spirit Who Comes From God, so that we may understand what has been freely given to us by God. We also speak these things, not in words taught by human wisdom, but in those taught by the Spirit, explaining spiritual things to spiritual people. (1 Corinthians 2:11-13 CSB)

**Spirit of Grace & Prayer** > I will pour out a Spirit of Grace and Prayer on the family of David and on the people of Jerusalem. They will look on me whom they have pierced and mourn for him as for an Only Son. They will grieve bitterly for him as for a Firstborn Son who has died. (Zechariah 12:10 NLT)

**Spirit of Jesus** > They went to Phrygia, and then on through the region of Galatia. Their plan was to turn west into Asia province, but the Holy Spirit blocked that route. So they went to Mysia and tried to go north to Bithynia, but the Spirit of Jesus wouldn't let them go there either. Proceeding on through Mysia, they went down to the seaport Troas. That night Paul had a dream. He saw a Macedonian standing on the far shore who called across the sea, "Come over to Macedonia and help us!" The dream gave Paul his map. (Acts 16:6-9 MSG)

**Spirit of Life** > Therefore, there is now no condemnation for those in Christ Jesus, because the law of the Spirit of Life in Christ Jesus has set you free from the law of sin and death. (Romans 8:1-2 CSB)

**Spirit of Prophecy** > The angel said to me, "Write this: Blessed are those who are invited to the marriage supper of the Lamb." And he said to me, "These are the true words of God." Then I fell down at his feet to worship him, but he said to me, "You must not do that! I am a fellow servant with you and your brothers who hold to the testimony of Jesus. Worship God." For the Testimony of Jesus is the Spirit of Prophecy. (Revelation 19:9-10 ESV)

**Spirit of Our Father** > When they bring you to trial, do not worry about what you are going to say or how you will say it. When the time comes, you will be given what you will say. For the words you will speak will not be yours; they will come from the Spirit of Our Father speaking through you. (Matthew 10:19-20 GNB)

**Spirit of the Living God** > The only letter of recommendation we need is you yourselves. Your lives are a letter written in our hearts; everyone can read it and recognize our good work among you. Clearly, you are a letter from Christ showing the result of our ministry among you. This “letter” is written not with pen and ink, but with the Spirit of the Living God. It is carved not on tablets of stone, but on human hearts. (2 Corinthians 3:2-3 NLT)

**Spirit of the Lord** > He commanded the chariot to stop, and they both went down into the water, Philip and the eunuch, and he baptized him. And when they came up out of the water, the Spirit of the Lord carried Philip away, and the eunuch saw him no more, and went on his way rejoicing. (Acts 8:38-39 ESV)

**Spirit of the LORD God** > The Spirit of the LORD God is on me, because the LORD has chosen me to bring good news to poor people. He has sent me to heal those with a sad heart. He has sent me to tell those who are being held and those in prison that they can go free. He has sent me to tell about the year of the LORD’s favor, and the day our God will bring punishment. He has sent me to comfort all who are filled with sorrow. (Isaiah 61:1-2 NLT)

**Spirit of Truth** > But when he, the Spirit of Truth, comes, he will guide you into all the Truth. He will not speak on his own; he will speak only what he hears, and he will tell you what is yet to come. He will glorify me because it is from me that he will receive what he will make known to you. (John 16:13-14 NIV)

**Spirit of Wisdom & Revelation** > May the God of our Lord Jesus Christ, the Father of Glory, give to you the Spirit of Wisdom and Revelation in the knowledge of him, the eyes of your understanding be enlightened; that you may know what is the hope of his calling, what are the riches of the glory of his inheritance in the saints, and what is the exceeding greatness of his power toward us who believe, according to the working of his mighty power. (Ephesians 1:17-19 NKJV)

**Spiritual Rock** > I don't want you to forget, dear brothers and sisters, about our ancestors in the wilderness long ago. All of them were guided by a cloud that moved ahead of them, and all of them walked through the sea on dry ground. In the cloud and in the sea, all of them were baptized as followers of Moses. All of them ate the same Spiritual Food, and all of them drank the same Spiritual Water. For they drank from the Spiritual Rock that traveled with them, and that Rock was Christ. (1 Corinthians 10:1-4 NLT)

**Steadfast Spirit** > Turn Your face away from my sins and blot out all my guilt. God, create a clean heart for me and renew a Steadfast Spirit within me. (Psalm 51:9-10 HCSB)

**Strength & Song** > The LORD is my Strength and my Song; he has become my Salvation. This is my God, and I will praise him, my father's God, and I will exalt him. The LORD is a Warrior; Yahweh is his name. (Exodus 15:2-3 HCSB)

**Strong Tower** > The name of the LORD is a Strong Tower; the righteous man runs into it and is safe. (Proverbs 18:10 ESV)

**Sure Foundation** > The LORD is exalted, for he dwells on high; he will fill Zion with his justice and righteousness. He will be the Sure Foundation for your times, a rich Store of Salvation, Wisdom, and Knowledge; the fear of the LORD is the key to this treasure. (Isaiah 33:5-6 NIV)

**Teacher** > Yet the LORD still waits for you to come to him so he can show you his love; he will conquer you to bless you, just as he said. For the LORD is faithful to his promises. Blessed are all those who wait for him to help them. O my people in Jerusalem, you shall weep no more, for he will surely be gracious to you at the sound of your cry. He will answer you. Though he give you the bread of adversity and water of affliction, yet he will be with you to teach you—with your own eyes you will see your Teacher. And if you leave God's paths and go astray, you will hear a voice behind you say, "No, this is the Way; walk here." (Isaiah 30:18-21 TLB)

**True God** > We know that we belong to God even though the whole world is under the rule of the Evil One. We know that the Son of God has come and has given us understanding, so that we know the True God. We live in union with the True God—in union with his Son Jesus Christ. This is the True God, and this is Eternal Life. My children, keep yourselves safe from false gods! (1 John 5:19-21 GNT)

**True Light** > This True Light, coming into the world, gives light to every man. He came into the world. The world was made by him, but it did not know him. He came to his own, but his own did not receive him. He gave the right and the power to become children of

God to those who received him. He gave this to those who put their trust in his name. (John 1:9-12 NLV)

**Upright One** > The path of the righteous is level; you, the Upright One, make the way of the righteous smooth. Yes, LORD, walking in the way of your laws, we wait for you; your name and renown are the desire of our hearts. (Isaiah 26:7-8 NIV)

**Vine** > Jesus said, “Remain united to me, and I will remain united to you. A branch cannot bear fruit by itself; it can do so only if it remains in the Vine. In the same way, you cannot bear fruit unless you remain in me. I am the Vine, and you are the branches. Those who remain in me, and I in them, will bear much fruit; for you can do nothing without me.” (John 15:5-6 GNB)

**Vineyard Keeper** > Jesus said, “I am the True Vine, and My Father is the Vineyard Keeper. Every branch in Me that does not produce fruit, He removes. He prunes every branch that produces fruit so that it will produce more fruit.” (John 15:1-2 HCSB)

**Wall of Fire** > “For I,” says the LORD, “will be a Wall of Fire all around her, and I will be the Glory in her midst.” (Zechariah 2:5 NKJV)

**Way, Truth, and Life** > Jesus answered Thomas, “I am the Way, the Truth, and the Life; no one goes to the Father except by me. Now that you have known me, you will know my Father also. From now on, you do know him, and you have seen him.” (John 14:6-7 GNB)

**Way Maker** > I am the LORD, who opened a way through the waters, making a path right through the

sea. I called forth the mighty army of Egypt with all its chariots and horses, to lie beneath the waves, dead, their lives snuffed out like candlewicks. But forget all that—it is nothing compared to what I'm going to do! For I'm going to do a brand new thing. See, I have already begun! Don't you see it? I will make a road through the wilderness of the world for my people to go home, and create rivers for them in the desert! (Isaiah 43:16-19 TLB)

**Wonderful Counselor** > For to us a child is born, to us a Son is given, and the government will be on his shoulders. And he will be called Wonderful Counselor, Mighty God, Everlasting Father, Prince of Peace. Of the greatness of his government and peace there will be no end. He will reign on David's throne and over his kingdom, establishing and upholding it with justice and righteousness from that time on and forever. The zeal of the LORD Almighty will accomplish this. (Isaiah 9:6-7 NIV)

**Word** > The Word became flesh and made his dwelling among us. We have seen his glory, the glory of the One and Only Son, who came from the Father, full of grace and truth. (John testified concerning him. He cried out, saying, "This is the One I spoke about when I said, 'He who comes after me has surpassed me because he was before me.'") Out of his fullness we have all received grace in place of grace already given. For the law was given through Moses; grace and truth came through Jesus Christ. (John 1:14-17 NIV)

**Word of God** > For the Word of God is living and active, sharper than any two-edged sword, piercing to the division of soul and of spirit, of joints and of

marrow, and discerning the thoughts and intentions of the heart. And no creature is hidden from his sight, but all are naked and exposed to the eyes of Him to whom we must give account. (Hebrews 4:12-13 ESV)

**Word of Life** > In the beginning was the Word. The Word was with God, and the Word was God. He was with God in the beginning. All things were made through him, and apart from him nothing was made that has come into being. In him was Life, and the Life was the Light of men. (John 1:1-4 TLV)

**Yahweh** > God spoke to Moses, telling him, “Therefore tell the Israelites: I am Yahweh, and I will deliver you from the forced labor of the Egyptians and free you from slavery to them. I will redeem you with an outstretched arm and great acts of judgment. I will take you as my people, and I will be your God. You will know that I am Yahweh your God, who delivered you from the forced labor of the Egyptians. I will bring you to the land that I swore to give to Abraham, Isaac, and Jacob, and I will give it to you as a possession. I AM Yahweh.” (Exodus 6:6-8 HCSB)

**Yahweh Our Righteousness** > “The days are coming,” this is the LORD’s declaration, “when I will raise up a Righteous Branch of David. He will reign wisely as King and administer justice and righteousness in the land. In his days Judah will be saved, and Israel will dwell securely. This is what he will be named: Yahweh Our Righteousness.” (Jeremiah 23:5-6 HCSB)

**Yahweh Shalom** > The Angel of the LORD extended the tip of the staff that was in his hand and touched the meat and the unleavened bread. Fire came up from

the rock and consumed the meat and the unleavened bread. Then the Angel of the LORD vanished from his sight. When Gideon realized that he was the Angel of the LORD, he said, "Oh no, LORD God! I have seen the Angel of the LORD face to face!" But the LORD said to him, "Peace to you. Don't be afraid, for you will not die." So Gideon built an altar to the LORD there and called it "Yahweh Shalom." (Judges 6:21-24 HCSB)

**Zion's King** > The kings of earth set themselves up and rulers conspire together against Adonai and against his Anointed One: "Let's rip their chains apart, and throw their ropes off us!" He who sits in heaven laughs! Adonai mocks them. So he will speak to them in his anger, and terrify them in his fury: "I have set up my King upon Zion, my Holy Mountain." I will declare the decree of Adonai. He said to me: "You are my Son. Today, I have become your Father. Ask me, and I will give the nations as your inheritance, and the far reaches of the earth as your possession." (Psalm 2:2-8 TLV)
