Good Man - praying man, cloud, crown - Let me tell you a story about Job, a man whom God blessed that lost all of his wealth and everything he cared about.

Wealthy Tribe - father & children - Job was abundantly blessed. He faithfully worshiped God. He had many sons and daughters, servants, and livestock herds.

Generous Spirit - house, door, table, bread, cup - Job hosted many feasts at his house for all of his children and friends. They enjoyed life and practiced peace.

Personal Sacrifices - altar, animal, flames, smoke - Job desired above all to be faithful in God's sight. He regularly offered burnt sacrifices for his family's sins.
