



Jesus' Ascension

Acts 1:1-11

Risen King - Jesus cross, crown, Risen Christ - Jesus spent 40 days with his disciples after the resurrection. He proved he was alive, and he explained God's plans.

Fire Baptism - disciples, flames, cloud - Jesus told his disciples to remain in Jerusalem until they were baptized with the promised Holy Spirit's presence.

World Mission - earth, stars, evangelist, flame - Jesus told his disciples not to worry about when he would return. He said they would be his witnesses worldwide.

Return Home - angel, cloud, Jesus - Jesus went home to heaven, disappearing in a cloud. Two angels appeared and prophesied about Jesus' future return.
